1 *Take Action*

3 *Choose Tap Water*

Switch to non-toxic re-usable bottles you can fill at the tap for free. Refuse bottled water at restaurants and demand to be served tap water instead.

Bottled water companies currently don't need to identify their sources although in many cases their pricey product is nothing more than filtered tap water. Our precious water resources are being bottled up and exported in staggering amounts, yet we know little about how long
