

ENERGY EAST CANDIDATE PLEDGE:

Not worth the risk for Ontario

TransCanada's Energy East project would be the largest oil pipeline in North America. The vast majority of crude shipped through the pipeline is expected to be exported unrefined from ports in Quebec and New Brunswick.

The pipeline would carry diluted bitumen produced in the tar sands across some of Ontario's most important waterways. Diluted bitumen is different from conventional oil. It has been proven to sink when spilled in water, causing devastating environmental impacts that are nearly impossible to clean up.

Filling the pipeline would produce enough climate emissions to undo Ontario's progress in phasing out coal.
