SAMPLE QUESTIONS FOR FEDERAL CANDIDATES AND PARTY LEADERS

- What will you do to take bold action for the climate that ensures a just transition for workers, fights inequality and racism, and respects Indigenous rights and treaties?
 - What will you commit to that addresses the need for affordable, accessible, and safe transportation that protects and expands good, unionized jobs in manufacturing and transit driving?
 - If your party forms government, what will you do in your first 100 days in office to put in place a plan on the scale of a Green New Deal to address the urgency of the climate emergency?
 - What will you do to implement a Green New Deal with a just transition at its core to minimize the impacts on affected workers as we transition to a fossil fuel-free future, including prioritizing the creation of good unionized jobs, public services, and workers' rights?
 - What will you do to implement a Green New Deal that centres on Indigenous self-determination, including the implementation of the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples, the Calls to Action from the Truth and Reconciliation Commission, the Calls to Justice from the National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls, and respects Free, Prior and Informed Consent?
