The Ontario we want strengthens democracy. It must:

- Respect Indigenous sovereignty and guarantee free, prior, and informed consent.
- Guarantee every vote counts through a Citizens' Assembly on electoral reform.
- Remove corporate influence in decision-making at Queen's Park.
- Respect communities' decisions on issues that affect them.

CARE

The Ontario we want takes care of one another. It must:

- Protect the most vulnerable
 Ontarians during the pandemic
 through public health measures,
 increased health care staffing, paid
 sick days, and universal vaccine
 access.
- Strengthen health care and stop the privatization of hospital services, long-term care, and home care.
- Invest in high-quality, universal public services, including education, mental health, childcare, eldercare, and social services.

COMMUNITIES

The Ontario we want invests in affordable and sustainable communities. It must:

- Build deeply affordable communities, with a mix of housing and proximity to good jobs, high-quality services, and reliable public transit without downloading costs onto communities.
- Protect Ontario's farmland, greenspace, and ecosystems.
- Provide strong regulation and oversight of extractive industries.

CLIMATE JUSTICE

The Ontario we want fights climate change with bold and ambitious action. It must:

- Transition Ontario away from fossil fuels and towards renewable energy
- Support communities in that transition as they build resilience to a changing climate, especially those on the frontlines of the climate crisis.
- Create good green jobs and invest in retraining the workforce.
- Promote sustainable agriculture and protect farmlands.
- Invest in and expand public ownership of infrastructure, services, and utilities.
